

Catch up Funding 2018 – 2019 impact statement

The Year 7 Catch-up Premium is an additional funding stream that a school receives to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading and/or mathematics at the end of key stage 2.

Catch up Literacy and Numeracy pupils 2018 – 2019

On Entry;

31% of students were below the expected level in English

24% of Students were below in mathematics

Catch up funding and Spend

Catch up funding received: £19,307

Accelerated reader

The use of accelerated reader and star testing to support pupils with their reading.

Lexia

Aimed at pupils who are able to work independently on a phonics based reading program. Additional tasks are set by staff to support the individual

Planned for students to access one on one support

EAL

A specialised EAL teacher is employed to ensure that literacy is at a level where pupils are able to access the curriculum

Impact

The following shows the progress of pupils who achieved more than expected progress in English and mathematics against national figures and the rest of their year group

English

In English 72% of pupils made more than expected progress in the academic year.

Mathematics

In mathematics 42% of pupils made more than expected progress in the academic year.
