You have applied to continue your studies and to follow a course in the Sixth Form at Stanground Academy. I am writing to you to make an appointment for you to come into the Academy and discuss the best course for you in the light of your examination results.

The meeting will be to discuss your timetable; this could take up to one hour from your start time.

Your appointment is on **Wednesday 9 September 2020** at the following times:

If your plans have changed since you applied, will you be kind enough to let me know as soon as possible. If I do not hear from you, I will assume that this appointment is suitable and will expect you on the date above. **As you will be having your photograph taken for your student ID badge on this day you will need to be in business dress.**

Please find enclosed a copy of the Sixth Form dress code, which we would ask you to sign and return to the Sixth Form when you attend your appointment in September. A copy of the Sixth Form handbook is available to view on the website. **Please also remember to bring your GCSE results to this appointment.**

Lessons start on Monday **14 September 2020 at 8.35am**. You will need to be in the Academy by **8.20 am** at the latest.

We anticipate that we will be able to follow our normal procedures for the start of the new academic year, however, as we are following the Government's guidance at all times, this may be subject to change. It is imperative that we keep your safety and the safety of staff as paramount and this may affect how we can operate. We will notify you of any changes to dates or times as soon as possible.
