Dear Parent/ Carer

Re: Music Tuition at Stanground Academy

Music is a highly valued subject at Stanground Academy, both in the curriculum and in enrichment activities, and it is our aim to both drive music forwards and to introduce more students to the benefits that music can bring. One strand of this is the expansion of our music tuition offer.

The purpose of this letter is to outline our processes for music tuition, but also to gather the information required to ensure our music tuition offer can successfully serve the demand and interests of our students.

Music tuition is provided by peripatetic tutors and will take place at Stanground Academy during school hours. Where possible, weekly lessons will be on a rotational timetable to avoid regularly missing the same lesson.

Peripatetic Music Tutors

The contract for music tuition is directly between parents/ carers and the peripatetic tutor. Peripatetic tutors are responsible for invoicing/collecting lesson fees from parents/carers, and all payments should be made directly to the tutor.

Music Lesson Fees

Estimated lesson prices are outlined below.

Individual 20-minute lesson	£13-£14 per lesson
Individual 30-minute lesson	£19.50-£21 per lesson
Paired/Small Group lesson	£6.50-£7 per lesson

Assistance with funding can be requested by parents/ carers for whom the cost presents a barrier to accessing musical learning. Such requests for financial support will be considered on a case-by-case basis and will take several factors into account, including musical aptitude, musical potential, attendance and behaviour.

Other Information

Students will be encouraged to contribute to the life of the music department, whether this be through attending extra-curricular activities, supporting musical performances and events, or taking advantage of other musical opportunities that arise.
