We are pleased to inform you that our annual Careers Fair will be taking place on Wednesday 28th January during the Academy Day. This event is an exciting opportunity for students to explore a wide range of education, training, and employment pathways by engaging directly with visiting exhibitors.

Each year group will be given an allocated time slot to visit the Careers Fair with one of their class teachers. During this time, they can speak with representatives from various organisations, colleges, training providers, and employers to gather valuable information that can support their future planning. To help you support your child, we will also be providing a Careers Fair booklet.

This booklet includes:

- An overview of every exhibitor attending
- The pathways each organisation links to (e.g., apprenticeships, further education, higher education, training, employment)
- A clickable hyperlink for each company name, allowing you and your child to explore their website and learn more about what they offer

We encourage you to look through this booklet with your child before the event, perhaps plan who they want to visit and prepare any questions they may want to ask.

How the careers fair supports each year group:

- **Year 9:** This is an ideal opportunity to assist with their upcoming **GCSE options** decisions by discovering subjects, pathways, and careers they may be interested in.
- **Year 10:** Students can explore **work experience opportunities**, particularly if they have not yet secured a placement. They can also begin researching their **post-16 pathways**.
- **Year 11:** The fair provides a chance to meet potential **post-16 providers**, explore college and training options, and consider pathways that extend **beyond post-18**.
- **Year 12 and Year 13 (invite only):**
Students can use this time to explore **post-18 options**, including university routes, apprenticeships, employment opportunities, and gap-year pathways.

We look forward to providing this valuable experience to all our students and hope it will support them in making informed decisions about their future.
