Dear Parent/ Carers

Year 11 Arrangements

With the end of the half-term fast approaching, I wanted to update you regarding the arrangements for Year 11. Events at this time of year are important for students as they mark the ending of Year 11 and progression on to the next chapter of their journey. I would like to set out the arrangements to enable activities to run as smoothly as possible.

The vast majority of Year 11 students have been working extremely hard over the last few weeks and they have now completed all of the required assessments to inform their GCSE grades. It is critical that students do attend, as normal, on Monday to complete any outstanding assessments or required paperwork. Tuesday will be the final day for Year 11 in the Academy. We will be holding a number of events during the day on Tuesday to celebrate the hard work and achievements of the year group. Students do not need to bring lunch on this day as it will be provided.

There are a few house-keeping issues that we would like to remind you of before Tuesday:

Return of locker keys - all students should have emptied their lockers with all locker keys returned to the Year Team.

Return of DFE laptops – If your child is still in receipt of a DFE provided laptop, please ensure this is returned to the Academy to allow other students to access this provision.

It should be noted that students should be contactable throughout this fortnight as some students may be recalled to school if there is missing assessment evidence or another issue arises regarding their grading.
