**Re: Non-uniform day Friday 27 May 2022 – Years 7, 8, 9, 10 & 12**

On Friday 27 May 2022 (last day of this half term) we are raising money for the celebration of Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee. This event marks 70 years on the throne, the longest reigning monarch in British history. For this, students are invited to wear non-school uniform, specifically red, white or blue, the colours of the Union Jack flag.

Students are asked to make a £1 donation via Vericool to wear non-school uniform on this day. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept cash.

The money raised on Friday 27 May will go towards a wide school celebration in the final half term of this academic year. On this day, yet to be confirmed, we will celebrate with specific lessons acknowledging and celebrating the past 70 years of Queen Elizabeth II reign, from her coronation to the modern day. There will also be activities, music and food available for all students in the afternoon on the school field. Further information will go out about this closer to the celebration.

All non-uniform must be appropriate and modest; onesies and facial piercings are not acceptable. The Principal's decision on what constitutes appropriate dress is final. If in doubt, students should consult with tutors prior to this date.

Year 11 must wear their normal school uniform as they will have exams on this day.
