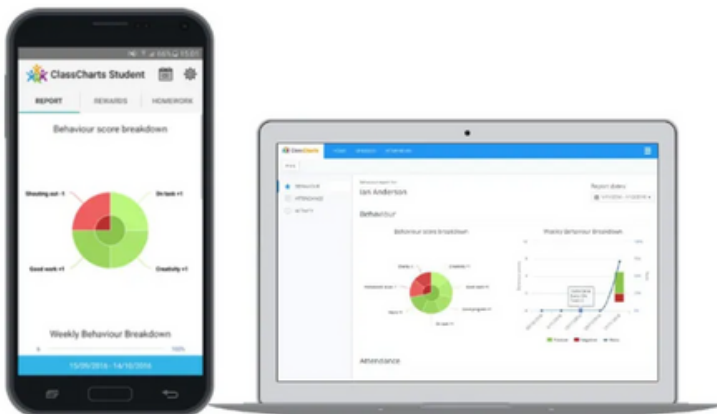
- Keep track of your child's behaviour

Step 1- Go to the Apple App Store or Google Play Store on your phone

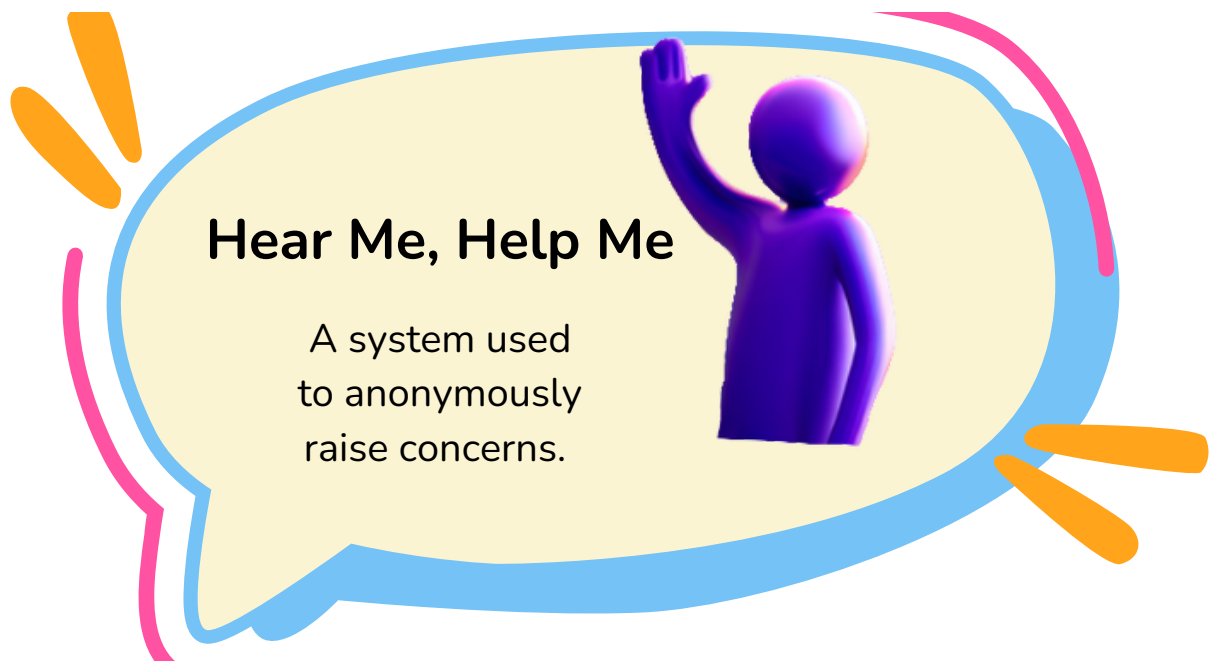
Step 2- Search for the Class Charts app and download

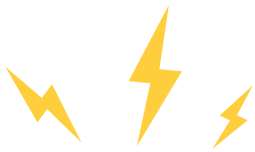

Get spotted doing something cool during break or lunch? Collect #caughtbeinggood tokens for instant rewards like chocolates, hot chocolate, or ice cream.



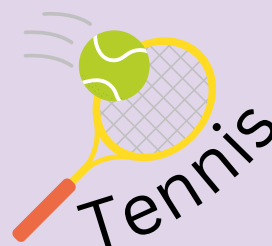

Use this map to familiarise yourself with your way around the academy. If you feel like you're lost, just ask a member of staff and we'll help you get there.

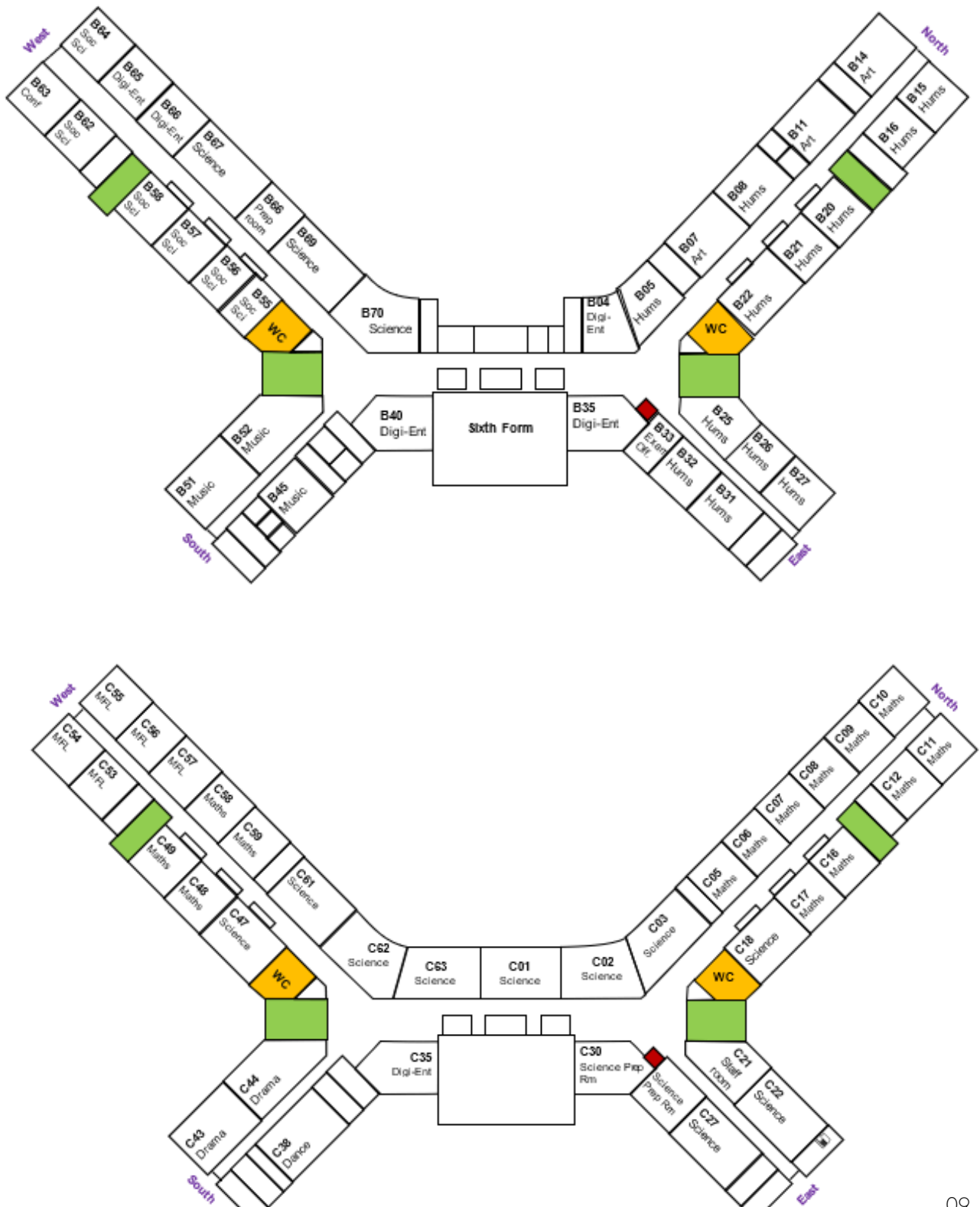
Academy Map
